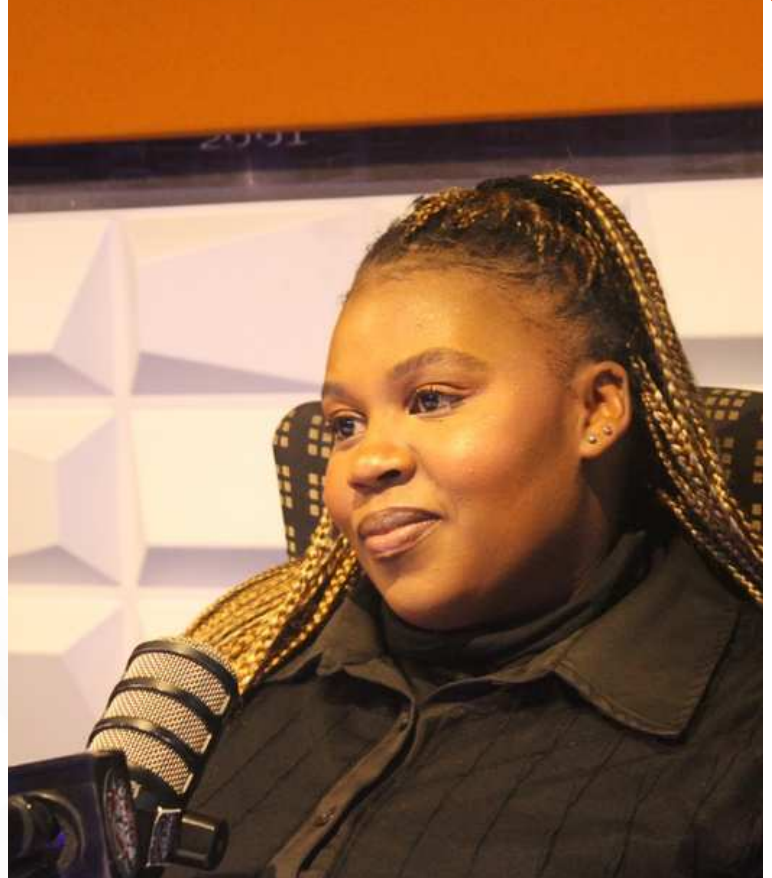
On air with Liderazgo
